Mildura Service to Cease

After three years of operating the Mildura to Adelaide return service Sharp Airlines announced it will cease this service with the last flight on the Sunday 28 August 2011.

“Sharp Airlines has grown to be a successful regional airline carrying 100,000 passengers a year between seven locations across three states. However the increasing costs associated with providing services to and from Mildura have forced us to assess its viability” said Sharp Airlines Managing Director, Mr Malcolm Sharp.

“The increased cost of future security screening charges, along with rising fuel prices and the cost of regulatory compliance have caused Sharp Airlines to make this difficult decision” said, Mr Malcolm Sharp.

“Sharp Airlines other services continue to grow and we look forward to working with these communities and exploring new opportunities, said Mr Malcolm Sharp
