

## SHARP AIRLINES & QANTAS INTERLINE AGREEMENT – Q&A

### Q1: What is the new interline agreement between Sharp Airlines and Qantas?

The new one-way interline agreement allows customers to book itineraries that combine Sharp Airlines and Qantas flights in a single booking. This means more convenient travel options to regional destinations across Victoria, Tasmania and the Bass Strait Islands.

### Q2: When will I be able to book combined Sharp Airlines and Qantas itineraries?

Once the agreement is live on qantas.com, you will be able to search and book itineraries that link Sharp Airlines and Qantas flights in one transaction.

### Q3: Can I use Qantas Points to book these combined itineraries?

Yes. Once live on qantas.com, Qantas Frequent Flyer members can use Qantas Points to make Classic Flight Reward bookings for itineraries that link Sharp Airlines and Qantas flights.

### Q4: How will baggage work when connecting between Sharp Airlines and Qantas at Essendon/Tullamarine?

Essendon Fields Airport (Sharp Airlines) and Melbourne Tullamarine Airport (Qantas) are separate airports.

If travelling Sharp → Qantas: You must collect your baggage at Essendon, make your own way to Melbourne Tullamarine, and check in with Qantas.

If travelling Qantas → Sharp: You must collect your baggage at Melbourne Tullamarine, make your own way to Essendon Fields, and check in with Sharp Airlines.

### Q5: Is transport provided between Essendon Fields and Melbourne Tullamarine?

No, passengers are responsible for their own transfer between the two airports. The journey typically takes 15–20 minutes by car or taxi, depending on traffic.

### Q6: Will my baggage be checked through from Sharp Airlines to Qantas (or vice versa) in Melbourne?

No. Due to the airport transfer between Essendon and Tullamarine, baggage cannot be through-checked. You will need to collect it and re-check it with your connecting airline.

### Q7: How much time should I allow for transfer time between Essendon Fields and Melbourne Tullamarine?

We recommend the following minimum connection times between scheduled arrival and departure times to ensure you have enough time to collect baggage, transfer between airports, and check in for your next flight.

If transferring from Qantas to Sharp Airlines allow at least 120 minutes connection time.

If transferring from Sharp Airlines to Qantas allow at least 100 minutes connection time.

### Q8: How do transfers work in Launceston?

In Launceston, Sharp Airlines and Qantas operate from different terminal areas.

All passengers must collect their baggage, exit the terminal, and transfer to the correct terminal and check-in for their next flight.

Allow sufficient time to collect baggage, transfer between terminals, and check in again .

If transferring from Qantas to Sharp Airlines allow at least 90 minutes connection time.

If transferring from Sharp Airlines to Qantas allow at least 75 minutes connection time.

### Q9: When will online bookings be available?

Interline bookings will only initially be available via travel agents. Online bookings will be available once it goes live on Qantas.com. This may take a little while and we will advise once it is live.
